9. Proper restraint should be exercised in the display of affection toward others.
10. The camp reserves the right to send any student home who is in violation of these rules with no refund.

All registrations made after that date must pay a higher fee. Canteen is included in registration fee.

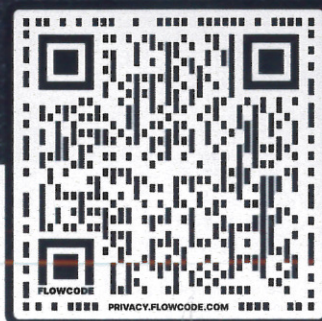
*First Chance Camp does not require a paid registration for each parent. All costs are included in the campers registration.

As the leader in Deaf ministry for over 50 years, Deaf Missions has been pivotal in leading Deaf people to know Jesus. Deaf people are one of the largest unreached people groups in the world. In 2020, Deaf Missions finished the first-ever translation of the entire Bible, allowing Deaf people to have a full Bible completely in American Sign Language (ASL). And now, Deaf Missions is producing a full-length feature film on the life of Jesus completely in ASL – for Deaf people, by Deaf people. This film will be released in April 2024 and it is anticipated to be one of the greatest evangelistic tools to reach the Deaf community. From its humble beginnings, Deaf Missions has reached Deaf people in all 50 states and more than 100 countries. The ministry is noted and respected among ministries with Deaf people and its outreach extends through more than 60 denominations.
